#### **DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT**

The quarry is intercalated limestone in a remnant of foliated quartz diorite of the MiddleTriassic Coast Plutonic rocks.

#### HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The quarry is located on Cunningham Island on the north side of Gumboat Pass, 17 miles SW of Ocean Falls. The property was owned by J.F. Beale in the late 1920's and early 1930's.

A mixed-feed lime-kiln burning about 10 tons per day and a lime-hydrating plant were built in 1930.

The quarry was producing from 1930 until 1934, when it was abandoned. The limestone was used mainly at the Ocean Falls pulp and paper plant.

## HISTORY OF PRODUCTION

During the period 1930-1933, inclusive, 38,768 tons of limestone were shipped from this property.
