DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

Open cuts expose two parallel shear zones, apparently in porphyritic andesite, each about 1½ feet wide, striking N65°E (mag.) and dipping northwesterly. A picked sample of the galena-sphalerite mineralization assayed: gold, 0.22 ounce per ton; silver, 66.5 ounces per ton; lead, 22.8%; zinc 14.6%.
