DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

Chalcopyrite is sparsely distributed in a contact metamorphic zone about 400 feet long and 40 to 60 feet wide. The zone occurs along the north contact of a small stock of granite, and consists of a mass of well-developed crystals of epidote and garnet, with chlorite and minor amounts of specular hematite, chalcopyrite, pyrite, and bismuthinite.

This occurrence is located near the headwaters of the west fork of Laventie Creek some 7 miles south of Tahtsa Lake. The property was staked during the summer of 1950 by C. McNeill of Ootsa Lake and G.A. Young of Vancouver.
