DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

Minor occurrences of mineralized quartz veins have been reported from Ear Lake and Kimsquit Lake. These are narrow quartz veins occurring in the metamorphic rocks. A sample of mineralized vein quartz from the west side of Ear Lake near the mouth assayed: gold, 1.88 ounces a ton; silver, 1.490 ounces a ton, and copper 3.68 per cent.
