DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

The adit is along a shear-zone striking N35°W and dipping 70°SW that cuts fine and coarse tuffs striking N10°W and dipping 65°E. Two open cuts have exposed the shear-zone 170 feet to the southeast and 90 feet to the northwest from the adit. In the adit the shear zone contains two narrow quartz stringers, 1 inch and 6 inches wide, respectively, and about 6 feet apart, mineralized with pyrite, galena, sphalerite, and arsenopyrite. A grab sample from the dump assayed: gold, 0.10 oz and silver, 6.3 oz per ton; lead, 1.4%; and zinc, 5.4%. East of this adit and a little lower on the mountain a shear zone that strikes N40°E and dips vertically is exposed for about 100 feet. The zone is about 2 feet wide and contains some quartz with which the minerals galena, arsenopyrite, and lollingite are associated.

These claims are located on the south side of Chikamin Mountain just below the summit, about 2 miles northwest of Eutsuk Lake. Development work consists of an adit about 25 feet long, known as the California, and some open cuts.
