DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

The northwesterly striking intrusive contact that crosses the Harrison group extends northwestward through the Old Timer No. 4 and No. 6 claims. The intrusive rock, chiefly diorite, is in contact with sheared chlorite schists, black slate, and dark grey laminated tuffs. Two quartz veins outcrop at an elevation of about 5,000 feet. One vein, striking N45°E and dipping 55° southeast, is enclosed with dark green sheared chlorite schist. It is exposed for a length of about 100 feet and ranges in width from 6 to 30 inches. The quartz is moderately well mineralized with pyrite, galena, sphalerite, and pyrrhotite. A sample of selected pieces assayed: gold, trace; silver, 1.3 oz. per ton. On the footwall side of the first vein is a second, striking N60°E and dipping 45° southeast. It outcrops for about 400 feet and ranges from 6 to 35 inches in width. The mineralization is similar to the first vein.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

This property, lying on the northeast slope of Lindquist Mountain, adjoins the northwest side of the Harrison group.

The old Timer group of 6 claims, the Old Timer Nos. 1 to 6, was located in 1944 by D.F. Kidd, of Vancouver. No work other than surface prospecting has been reported on this property.
