The northwesterly striking intrusive contact that crosses the Harrison group extends northwestward through the Old Timer No. 4 and No. 6 claims. The intrusive rock, chiefly diorite, is in contact with sheared chlorite schists, black slate, and dark grey laminated tuffs. Two quartz veins outcrop at an elevation of about 5,000 feet. One vein, striking N45°E and dipping 55° southeast, is enclosed with dark green sheared chlorite schist. It is exposed for a length of about 100 feet and ranges in width from 6 to 30 inches. The quartz is moderately well mineralized with pyrite, galena, sphalerite, and pyrrhotite. A sample of selected pieces assayed: gold, trace; silver, 1.3 oz. per ton. On the footwall side of the first vein is a second, striking N60°E and dipping 45° southeast. It outcrops for about 400 feet and ranges from 6 to 35 inches in width.
