DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

The country rock is argillite and quartzite overlain by volcanics, intruded in places by granodiorite and granitic dykes. There are several more or less parallel quartz veins which appear to follow in strike and dip the bedding-planes of the sedimentaries, which trend northeasterly and dip south-east at about 35°. While evidence of the existence of quartz veins has been obtained over a distance of about 5,000 feet along strike, there is no evidence that any particular vein is continuous for any distance. The veins, ranging from 2 to 6 feet in width, are sparsely mineralized with galena, zinc-blende, and pyrite, with low precious metal values. A selected sample from the widest showing assayed: gold, trace; silver, 2 oz. per ton; lead, 0.2%; zinc, 1.4%.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

This property is located on the northeastern spur of Mount Irma, at the head of a small creek flowing into the west end of Little Whitesail Lake. The showings, lying between elevations of 4,800 and 5,500 feet, were discovered and staked in 1929 by Messrs. Logan, Harrison, and Worth. Work during the year consisted of open cutting.
