This showing is located about a mile up the Chikamin Mountain trail from Whitesail Lake. The outcrop is some 900 feet higher than the lake and 100 yards east of the trail. The Dad's Special group of 4 claims was located by A. Ritz, of Wistaria.

Privateer Mines, Limited, in 1945 drilled one diamond-drill hole 134 feet long beneath the surface exposure.

DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

A small creek exposes an area of rusty weathering, pyritized tuffs about 25 feet wide. In the creek-bottom is a $\frac{1}{2}$ inch stringer of galena and a $\frac{1}{4}$ inch stringer of sphalerite, both striking north 45° west and dipping almost vertical.
