"Perlite flows in Nechako River area vary in colour from black to pearl grey. Such flows have been noted south of Uncha Lake, south of Cheslatta Lake, near the outlet of Ootsa Lake, and near the north end of Entiako Lake. Other flows may occur within the area, as the Ootsa Lake Group is widespread It is probable that deposits of commercial size and grade will be found when the demand is great enough". (Tipper, 1963, p. 54).
