The copper and molybdenum mineralization occurs in a host rock of medium-grained granodiorite.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located approximately 2 miles north of the east end of Laidman Lake.

The claim group, made up of L 1-52 & 53 Fraction, was owned in 1970 by Rio Tinto Canadian Exploration Limited. Their assessment work included 365 soil samples.

In 1971, Rio Tinto retained claims L 1-18. Some topographical mapping was done, and 315 soil samples taken.
