DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

Mineralization observed in the Takla Group rocks consists of chalcopyrite, and rarely bornite as disseminated grains and fracture coatings.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located on the north slope of Tatuk Hill, between elevations of 3,000 to 4,300 feet.

The Tat 1-28 claim group was owned in 1970 by the American Smelting and Refining Company. During that year geological mapping and geochemical soil surveying were carried out.

The group was still held by American Smelting in 1971, but no assessment work is reported for that year.
