Placer gold occurs in the bench gravels along the banks of the Nechako River.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located on the Nechako River at Miworth, 9 miles west of Prince George.

In 1935, a considerable volume of gravels were dredged by Nechako Golds, Ltd. Operations were suspended the following year.

HISTORY OF PRODUCTION

Recorded production up to and including 1945 totals 83 oz. of placer gold recovered from Nechako River.
