DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

A placer gold deposit of fine flaky gold occurs in the bench gravels along Norn Creek.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

Norn Creek flows about $2\frac{1}{2}$ miles northwest to meet the Ahbau creek at a point $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles east of Cinema.

The placer gold was discovered on this creek by Messrs. Hilton and North in 1882, and some hand working of the gravels done for the next year or so.

HISTORY OF PRODUCTION

Recorded production up to and including 1945, totals 5 oz. of placer gold.
