## DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The mineralization is associated with both a soft quartzsericite schist, and the enclosed quartz stringers.

A grab sample assayed: Gold, 0.24 oz., silver, 0.4 oz.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located on Hixon Creek, approximately 4 miles above the junction of Government and Hixon Creeks.

In 1918, the Belmont claim group consisted of the Mont Damon, Belmont, and Virginia claims, and was owned by Messrs. McLarty and Gillis. An adit was driven 135 feet.

This above group was restaked in 1926 by Messrs. Hahn and Strbac, as the Ceyanne group. Some grab samples were recovered from the adit and analyzed for mineral content.

In 1929, the Cevanne group was optioned by Cariboo Lode Mines, Limited, and the existing adit was extended to 175 feet. Further sampling was done in the adit.
