DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

The limited work done prior to 1952 disclosed two sections containing chalcopyrite in partly silicified sediments in a strong fault zone. Sampling of one width of 20 feet indicated an average grade of 4.0% copper. In another section, 60 feet by 25 feet, sampling gave an average assay of 0.65% copper.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

This occurrence is located on the west bank of the Fraser River about 3 miles west of Hutton and some 40 miles east-northeast of Prince George.

The showings have been known for many years but no early work has been reported. The showings were examined by Dr. A.C. Skerl, consulting geologist, in 1951. A group of 18 claims covering the showings were held in 1956 by Rio Canadian Exploration Ltd., under option from De Soto Mines Limited. During the year about 2,500 square feet of bedrock was exposed by bulldozer stripping and sluicing; diamond drilling totalling 148 feet was done in one hole but core recovery was poor; soil sampling was also reported at that time.
