DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

It is reported that the showing consists of scattered chalcopyrite mineralization in a silicified zone in argillites and limestones. A sample across the best mineralization exposed (9 inch width) assayed: Gold, trace; silver, 0.8 oz/ton; copper, 25.5%.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

This property is located on what is known locally as Mine Creek, a tributary of the McGregor River, some 45 miles north-east of Prince George.

The Copper Gulch claim, located on the showings, was owned by Martin Framstad, of Prince George, in 1928; no work was reported at that time. De Soto Mines Limited, incorporated August 1955, acquired 17 claims and fractions covering the showings. Rio Canadian Exploration Ltd. held the property under option in 1956. Work during the year included soil sampling, and 495 feet of diamond drilling in 2 holes.
