DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

The mineralization is reported to occur as a replacement in limestone. A 10 foot diamond drill section is reported to have assayed 3.5 ounces a ton in silver, 8% combined lead-zinc, and some cadmium.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT  
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

This property is located between the 2,000 and 2,600 foot elevation 2 miles east of Giscome.

It is reported that in 1959 geophysical surveys were made and 4 holes were diamond drilled on this ground. The Samson 1-22 and JHG 1-10 claims, owned by J.H. Gerlitzkie, were held under option by Vanco Explorations Limited, whose exploration program was financed on a 50-50 basis by Steep Rock Iron Mines Limited and Labrador Mining and Exploration Company Limited. Work by the company during 1964-65 included a geochemical survey and geological mapping; the option was subsequently dropped.

A private company, J.H.G. Mining Co. Ltd., was incorporated by the owner of the property in August 1967; the company was converted to public status and the name changed to Central B.C. Exploration Ltd. later that same month. The property was expanded to 100 claims, including the Samson 1-36, Tin 1-14, Can 1-40, and J.H.G. 1-10. Work by the company in 1968 included magnetometer and gravity surveys, geochemical survey of the Can group, trenching, and 4,422 feet of diamond drilling in 16 holes. During 1969 a geochemical soil survey (858 samples), trenching, and 6,841 feet of diamond drilling in 12 holes was carried out. Work during 1970 and 1971 included geological mapping, geochemical soil and silt surveys (1,655 samples in 1970), and trenching.
