HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located at about the 4,000 foot elevation west of Butterfield Lake, 15 miles northwest of the east end of Babine Lake.

Royal Canadian Ventures Ltd. held the BL group of 37 claims in 1969. An additional 70 claims were staked in 1970. Work during 1970 included geological mapping, magnetometer and electromagnetic surveys over 40 line-miles, and a geochemical soil survey (1,080 samples). In 1971 the property consisted of the BL 1-59 claims. Work during 1971 included 165 feet of diamond drilling in 2 holes on BL 22 and 57 claims.

DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

Disseminated chalcopyrite is present in pyroxene porphyry and in coarse gabbroic pyroxenite. Chalcopyrite and malachite were noted in andesites near pyrite-bearing tuff beds.
