DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

Minor chalcopyrite, sphalerite and molybdenite are disseminated in fractures and quartz stringers in feldspathised granodiorite.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

This property is located at about the 3,000 foot elevation on the northwest slope of Nithi Mountain, about 8 miles southeast of Endako village.

Julian Mining Co. Ltd., owned by Anaconda (60%) and Wenner-Gren (40%), acquired the KO group of 179 recorded claims in 1963. Work during the year included a magnetometer survey over 104,000 feet of line, 2,300 soil samples, and 360 feet of light diamond drilling. This was followed in 1964 by a magnetic survey, geological mapping, and trenching. The property was subsequently reduced to 20 claims. Further geophysical work was reported in 1965.
