HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located at elevations of 2,500 to 2,800 feet on Sam Ross Creek, 9 miles west of the village of Endako.

The Lorne group of 35 claims was held by Amax Exploration, Inc. Work during the period 1966-1968 included geological mapping, geophysical and geochemical surveys, trenching, and 638 feet of diamond drilling in one hole.
