DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

At the more southerly showing, on or near the Fran 40 claim about 1 mile south-southwest of the Endako mine, disseminated molybdenite and more abundant pyrite occurs in altered, fractured granite with chloritized biotite.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT  
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

This property is located 6½ miles southwest of Endako, adjoining the western boundary of Endako Mines Ltd. near its southern end.

The Rob group of 28 recorded claims was acquired by Utica Mines Ltd. in about 1962. Endako Mines Ltd. optioned the property in January 1963 and during the year carried out geological and geochemical surveys. Further work during 1964-65 included trenching and about 3,000 feet of diamond drilling. No significant molybdenite mineralization was intersected. The drilling was done on showings near the north boundary of the property.

Utica Mines carried out a geochemical survey over the property (Rob 1-22 and 6 Fran claims) in 1971. The company name was changed in September 1971 to Dankoe Mines Ltd.
