HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT  
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

This property is located at the 3,400 foot elevation on the west side of Taltapin Mountain, about 5 miles south of Babine Lake.

The Anderson claim (Lot 2490) was Crown-granted to Chas. S. Anderson in 1919. Considerable surface stripping was done and a prospecting adit 50 feet in length driven, but only a few sparsely mineralized zones were revealed.

DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

Quartz veins occur in a roof pendant of well-banded greenstones of the Cache Creek group, which are carbonatized and silicified. Grey augite andesite dykes cut both the greenstones and granite which outcrop in the immediate vicinity. The best showings consist of quartz veins 2 to 10 inches wide, striking about N30°W, which contain galena, pyrite, and a little chlorite and white mica. Several east-west striking quartz veins farther up the hill show some copper staining.
