This occurrence is located about $\frac{1}{2}$ mile east of Fort St. James.

A group of claims was staked on the occurrence by R. Baker and associates prior to 1942.

Ajax Mercury Mines Limited, incorporated in January 1966, acquired 24 claims covering this occurrence. A geochemical survey was carried out in 1967.
