HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located at elevations of 3,500-4,500 feet at the head of Hubert Creek, 8 miles south of Telkwa.

The Bill 3-6, 10 & 11 claims, owned by Heinz Langner, were optioned by Anglo-Bomarc Mines Ltd. in about 1974. Langner had blasted a long deep trench across a rock bluff to expose the showing. The company optioned 36 additional claims (Jo 1-12 and Bill 25-48) from Leslie M. Hart, of Vancouver. These claims cover a prominent aeromagnetic anomaly, the peak of which lies a mile and a half north-west of the copper showing.

OWNER OR OPERATOR AND ADDRESS

DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The underlying rocks are Jurassic volcanics of the Hazelton group, comprising red, purple, and dark green andesites with minor limey bands and lenses. A weak shear zone about 250 feet in width trends N20°E and dips vertical. Mineralization, as exposed in a trench, consists of finely disseminated to massive chalcopyrite with minor quartz distributed along fractures and faults within the shear zone. The host rock is a massive dark green to black andesite. A visual estimate of the average grade across the 250 foot width is 0.15 to 0.20% copper.
