HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located at about the 5,500 foot elevation at the head of a creek which flows northerly into the Telkwa River about 3 miles west of Howson Creek, approximately 21 miles southwest of Smithers.

The Whisteling Wind, Copper Mountain, Copper Hill, Lakeside, and Copper Dyke claims (Lots 1859-1863) were Crown-granted to C.D. Rand in 1909. Open cuts and stripping was reported in 1909 on the adjacent Copper Dome, Copper Bluff, Copper Basin, Copper Ridge, Copper Peak, and Bell Mare claims (Lots 3398-3404), which were Crown-granted to C.D. Rand in 1911.
