DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT
A dyke 6 to 8 feet wide strikes northeast and dips near vertical, cutting brecciated andesite. Mineralization, which occurs along the wall of, and partly in the body of the dyke, consists mainly of sphalerite, arsenopyrite, pyrite, and lesser amounts of galena and chalcopyrite in a gangue of silicified and altered dyke rock and some quartz. A sample from a 4 foot width of mineralization exposed in an open cut assayed: gold, 0.17 ounce per ton; silver, 2.7 ounces per ton; zinc, 3.8%.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located at about the 4,700 foot elevation on the east bank of Sloan Creek, on the Southwest side of Hudson Bay Mountain, 7 miles west of Smithers.

The Dominion and Newcastle claims were owned by C. Hastings. Exploration work for the period from about 1908 to 1914 included open cuts and a 25 foot shaft.

The ground was apparently held from about 1927 as the Torrent and Margaret claims. Sil-Van Consolidated Mining and Milling Company, Ltd., incorporated in September 1950, acquired 51 claims in this vicinity. The company name was changed in May 1957 to Sil-Van Mines Limited. An electromagnetic survey was carried out over the Torrent and adjacent claims in 1963.
