HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located at the 5,360 foot elevation and about 1,000 feet above Higgins Creek, some 18 miles north-east of Smithers.

The Fisher group of claims was owned by E. Simpson and J.C. Sealey from about 1918 until about 1929. Trenching was reported.

OWNER OR OPERATOR AND ADDRESS

DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

At elevation 5,360 feet, about 1,000 feet above the creek on the steep mountain-slope, there is exposed a band of rhyolite which is irregularly mineralized with malachite. At the best mineralized point the width is 25 feet. A sample across this width assayed traces of gold and silver and 0.4 per cent copper.
