The area is largely devoid of outcrop. Some basic volcanics are present. The drill holes cut diorite containing magnetite.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

93 L/16 FE 1

The property is located on the north side of Fulton Lake, 7½ miles west of Topley Landing.

The Badge 1-14 claims were held in 1969 by The Granby Mining Company Limited. Soil geochemical and magnetometer surveys were carried out over the entire property. In 1970 the property was reduced to the Badge 5-12 claims. Diamond drilling was done in 2 holes totalling 749 feet on Badge 5 and 9 claims.
