DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

Several minor showings of zinc and copper-bearing mineralization are found associated with fracturing in Hazelton Group volcanic rocks.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located at about the 3,000 foot elevation 2 miles west of Tsalit Mountain and 2 miles south of Morice River, 20 miles southwest of Houston.

The Hagas 1-37 and HR 1-10 claims, owned by J.M. McAndrew, were under option in 1972 by Perry, Knox, Kaufman, Inc., of Spokane, and Sun Oil Company, of Texas. The former company carried out a geochemical soil survey (175 samples) over 10 claims. Sun Oil carried out an electromagnetic survey. During 1973 Perry, Knox, Kaufman Inc. carried out an electromagnetic survey over 2.4 line-miles on Hagas 3-6, 14, 16, 18, and 605 feet of diamond drilling in 2 holes on Hagas 6 and 16.
