DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The claims are underlain by Hazelton volcanic and sedimentary rocks intruded by granitic plugs and stocks. Chalcopyrite and pyrite are found in occasional shears and as weak disseminations in strongly epidotized volcanic rocks. Bornite and chalcopyrite occur as fine disseminations in one fault zone adjacent to a volcanic-intrusive contact.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located at approximately 5,500 feet elevation 1 mile north of the peak of Mount Loring, 48 miles southwest of Houston.
