HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located at approximately 4,500 feet elevation on a tributary of Gosnell Creek, 2 miles west of Nanika Mountain forestry lookout, 40 miles southwest of Houston.

The MO 1-14 claims were held by El Paso Mining and Milling Company in 1972. Reconnaissance geological mapping at 1 inch equals 1,000 feet was carried out over all claims.
