HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located at the 5,500 foot elevation at the head of a southwest tributary of Starr Creek, approximately 28 miles southwest of Smithers.

The Wolverine 1-6 and LG 1-28 claims were held in 1971 by The Granby Mining Company Limited. Work during the year included geological mapping, a geochemical soil survey (339 samples) covering Wolverine 1-6, and 426 feet of trenching on Wolverine 1-4.
