DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The claims are underlain by Hazelton Group andesite and rhyolite, which to the south are intruded by diorite. A shear zone on Rudy 1 is exposed over an area of 3 feet by 8 feet and carries abundant bornite. A quartz vein on Rudy 2 is 6 inches thick and carries sphalerite, chalcopyrite, and tetrahedrite.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located at about the 4,500 foot elevation on the east side of Houston Tommy Creek, 20 miles west of Houston.

The Rudy 1-8 claims were held in 1973 by Maharaja Minerals, Limited. Geological mapping and rock sampling was carried out over Rudy 1-4 claims.
