The property is located on the south slope of Mount Harry Davis, about 1 mile north of Houston. A small mineralized exposure occurs near the bend in the right-of-way of the British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority power transmission-line, about 3,600 feet south of the ED showing (93 L/7, CU 7).

The Barb 3-6, 17, 19, and 35 other claims and fractions were held in 1970 by Falconbridge Nickel Mines Limited. A reconnaissance geological survey was carried out.
