DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The property is largely covered with glacial deposits. Meta-andesite and quartz monzonite are present. Pyrite and minor chalcopyrite are disseminated in both rocks.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located near the junction of Tachek and Strimboldh Creeks approximately 12 miles north of Topley.

The Cougar group of 40 claims was held by Nittetsu Mining Co., Ltd., during 1970-1971. A reconnaissance induced potential survey was carried out over 9.4 line-miles in 1970. Work during 1971 included geological mapping, and an induced potential survey over 11.4 line-miles.
