HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT  
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

This property lies at the 6,500 foot elevation at the head of Goathead Creek on Kiskeyas Peak, 36 miles north-northeast of Hazelton.

The Fog and Frost claims cover showings formerly known as the Ole group. They comprise 20 recorded mineral claims held by Amax Exploration, Inc. Work by the company in 1966 included the mapping of an area 2,400 by 4,800 feet, the drilling and blasting of two trenches having a total length of 138 feet, and diamond drilling in one hole to a depth of 1,486 feet.

Sicintine Mines Ltd., which was organized in August 1967, acquired the property and subsequently optioned it to Canadian Superior Exploration Limited. A program of trenching and sampling was carried out during the year.
