DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT
The country rocks are chiefly flat dipping volcanic tuffs. A system of fracturing striking N60°W (mag) with a steep southwest dip crosses the beds of tuffs. Mineralization consisting essentially of bornite follows the fracturing and is in part disseminated through the country rock. The best exposure occurs on the north wall of the south basin. At this point a width of 23 feet is well mineralized and a further width more sparingly mineralized. A chip sample across 23 feet assayed: gold, 0.01 ounces a ton; silver, 2.2 ounces a ton; copper, 1.2%. (B.C. Annual Report, 1930).

The Cominco Ltd. Annual Report for 1930 describes the showing as follows: The mineralization consists principally of bornite, with some chalcopyrite carrying silver, occurring in amygdaloidal basalt. Several open cuts showed values averaging 2.45% copper and 3 ounces of silver over widths of 25 feet.
