DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

Veins containing sphalerite, galena, jamesonite, and pyrite in a gangue of quartz and siderite are found in Bowser sedimentary rocks near an intrusive diorite contact. As exposed in the main trench these rocks are predominantly quartzites, feldspathic quartzites and siltstones striking approximately N27 E and dip 34 southeast. The mineralization, in the exposure along Showing creek, also occurs as partial replacement of two beds up to 8 or 10 inches in thickness. Two new occurrences of sulphide mineralization were found during construction of an access road from Harold Price Creek.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located at about the 2,500 foot elevation on the northeasterly slope of Blunt Mountain, 20 miles east of Hazelton.

The MG 1-14 claims were held by Utah Construction and Mining Co. Geological mapping, electromagnetic and geochemical soil surveys, and diamond drilling in 3 x-ray holes totalling 338 feet was carried out in 1968. Work in 1970 included further geological mapping and 33 line-miles of electromagnetic survey.

The Max claim (6 units) was staked in September 1975 by John Young and Maxwell Martin on behalf of themselves and Georgia Resources Inc. By an agreement of November 1977 Rebel Developments Ltd. optioned a 100% interest in the property. Staking by Rebel in late 1977 and early 1978 was done in the Martin 1-6 claims (56 units). Work by the company at that time included trenching and diamond drilling.
