DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT
An altered aplite dyke 9 feet wide strikes southerly and dips 75° west in granodiorite. The dyke is cut by small quartz stringers over a width of 4 feet on the hanging-wall side, and the silicified rock is impregnated with a little pyrite and chalcopyrite. A representative sample of the mineralized rock assayed: gold, trace; silver, 1.06 ounces a ton; copper, 0.22%. At elevation 4,000 feet the 9-foot dyke is approached by a flat-lying pegmatitic dyke about 6 feet wide which is bleached and somewhat altered, and is impregnated with a little disseminated pyrite and chalcopyrite. A representative sample of the mineralized rock collected from the face of a drift on the pegmatitic dyke assayed: gold, trace; silver, 0.53 ounce a ton; copper, 0.39%.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

This property is located at the 3,900 foot elevation at the head of Station (Mission) Creek on the north slope of Rocher Deboule Mountain, 3 miles south of New Hazelton.

The Blue Bird group, consisting of the Blue Bird, Elizabeth, and Bromide claims, was owned by G.B. Tallman, of New Hazelton, in 1918. Exploration work at that time had been done in one adit driven 36 feet. The Hecla group, owned by Mr. Tallman in the 1930's, was apparently a restaking of the Blue Bird group. Exploration work reported on the Hecla group included open cutting, and a 20 ft. long crosscut adit with a 30 foot drift.
