DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

The occurrence consists of a vein 6 to 8 inches wide striking northeasterly and dipping 65° northwest in a quartzite formation. The vein filling is mainly arsenopyrite, together with some quartz. Samples of the arsenopyrite are reported to have assayed from \$5 to \$12 a ton in gold, and from 1 to 3 ounces a ton in silver.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

This occurrence is located at the 5,750 foot elevation on a steep mountain side about 2 miles westerly from Thoen basin, and some 24 miles east-northeast of Hazelton. Thoen basin lies southeast of the summit of Thoen Mountain.

The Babine claim covered this occurrence in 1921; no development work has been reported.
