Chalcopyrite, pyrite, and molybdenite are disseminated and occur in quartz veinlets occupying fractures in quartz monzonite.

## HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located between elevations of 4,900 and 5,600 feet, 4 miles west of Theon Mountain.

The Tyee claim group was held in 1966 by Falconbridge Nickel Mines, Limited. A geological survey was carried out at that time.

The King 15-54 claims were held in 1968 by Mastodon-Highland Bell Mines Limited. Work included geological mapping, induced polarization and magnetometer surveys.
