## HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located at about the 4,000 foot elevation 4 miles north of the south end of Nakinilerak Lake, 54 miles northeast of Smithers.

Reconnaissance magnetometer surveying of the area began in 1970 by Lacanex Mining Company Limited and Twin Peak Mines Ltd. The Lynn 1-48 claims were staked in 1971 and geophysical and soil geochemical surveys carried out. Ducanex Resources Limited, owned by Dupont of Canada and Lacanex Mining, began diamond drilling the half-mile anomalous area in 1972; this work gave indications of a new porphyry copper zone under 75 feet of overburden.
