Chalcopyrite and bornite are disseminated through the hybrid contact zone between Takla volcanics and the Hogem batholith.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located at elevations of 5,000 to 6,000 feet, 21 miles west-southwest of Germansen Landing.

North Star Explorations Ltd. held the property in 1969.

The showings were reportedly discovered in 1965. North Star Explorations Ltd. held the property in 1966 as the Bob group and carried out a geological survey. The claims were restaked in 1968. Further geological work was reported by the company in 1969.

Kaza Copper Ltd. held 25 claims in the Slide, Tom, Jean, Lee, and Jim groups in 1972. Trenching was reported on the Slide group.
