## HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located at approximately 3,700 feet elevation on the north side of Kwanika Creek, 8 miles northeast of Tsayta Lake.

The Lin group of some 90 claims was owned in 1972 by W.R. Bacon. The Luc Syndicate carried out a geochemical soil survey (approximately 700 samples).
