Chalcopyrite occurs in fractures. Syenite intrudes quartz monzonites of the Hogen batholith.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located 17 miles north-northwest of Old Hogen, at approximately 4,500 feet elevation.

The Flame 1-64 claims were held in 1974 by Thor Explorations Ltd. Work during the year included a magnetometer survey over 51.3 line-miles and a geochemical soil survey (1,310 samples) over 49.2 line miles covering all claims.
