DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The claims lie entirely within the Hogen batholith. Rocks exposed on the property consist mainly of diorite, syenite, and monzonite, with dykes of pegmatite. Copper mineralization occurs in shear zones, associated with syenite and potash feldspar fracture filling.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located near the head of Duckling Creek some 28 miles northwest of Germansen Landing.

The Ted group, totalling 117 claims, was held by Tupco Mines Ltd. in 1972. Work included geological mapping, an induced polarization survey over 6.7 line-miles covering 24 claims, and a geochemical soil survey (1,456 samples).
