HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located between Duckling and Haha Creeks, approximately 30 miles northwest of Germansen Landing.

The Col 1-32, 51-58 claims were owned in 1972 by W.R. Bacon. The LUC Syndicate carried out geological mapping and a geochemical soil survey.

DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The claims are underlain by basic rocks intruded by the Duckling Creek syenite complex, phases of the Hogem batholith. Mineralization includes sparsely disseminated chalcopyrite, mainly in syenite, and rare bornite veinlets and disseminated grains.
