DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT/DESCRIPTION DU GISEMENT

A quartz vein 10 to 12 feet in width strikes southwesterly and appears to follow the planes of schistosity of the enclosing schists. The vein is sparsely mineralized with pyrite and chalcopyrite. A sample of selected portions of mineralization assayed: gold, trace; silver, 0.6 ounce a ton; copper, 1%.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT
HISTORIQUE DE L'EXPLORATION ET DE LA MISE EN VALEUR

This occurrence is located on the west side of the Germansen River, just below the mouth of Plughat Creek, about 1 mile southeast of Germansen Landing.

The Sunset claim group was owned by O.J. Crites, of Manson Creek, in the early 1930's. Exploration work was done in a 120 foot long drift adit, located just above the river. The claims lapsed prior to 1938.
