DESCRIPTION OF DEPOSIT

The claims are underlain by a massive, thick-bedded, grey to black limestone unit with fine grey, sometimes brecciated, coarse white-cream dolomitic zones which is overlain by grey slates (Middle Devonian?). Mineralization includes disseminated fine galena, coarse light sphalerite, and minor pyrite in stockworks crosscutting the carbonate unit. Iron oxide and cerussite occur in bleached stockwork.

HISTORY OF EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT

The property is located 7 miles north-northeast of Nina Lake, between 4,500 and 5,600 feet elevation.
